

COWBOY DAYS “HALE ON WHEELS” BIKE RIDE

What?

A recreational bicycle ride in Plainview, *Hale* County, Texas, during the annual “Cowboy Days” Celebration. Your family can watch the “Down Ol’ Broadway Cattle Drive”, and you and family can take a stagecoach ride, climb the climbing wall, jump in the “jumpy” house, enjoy a classic car show, and savor the chuck wagon food, homemade ice cream, and other treats. Four routes are offered: 21, 32, 48, and 62 miles. Go to www.plainviewtexaschamber.com for routes and maps.

A Bar-B-Que lunch, free for riders, is provided at the finish. First class rest stops, such as the “Last Chance Saloon”, are provided at frequent intervals. All riders receive a “Hale on Wheels” T-shirt, water bottle, tote bag, and other goodies. Sag, mechanical, and medical support will be provided.

First to finish in the mens’ and womens’ divisions in the 48 and 62 mile routes each receive a \$ 50 cash award and second in each division, \$ 25.

A chuck wagon breakfast, served in the starting area, will be available for a nominal charge beginning at 7:30 A.M. on the day of the ride.

When?

September 19, 2009, start at 8:30 AM. All routes will start and finish on Southwest 20th Street, in Plainview, just north of the Ollie Liner Center.

Where?

Ollie Liner Center, 2000 South Columbia, Plainview, Texas. Ample parking and restrooms will be available at start and finish. Showers will also be available nearby.

Enjoy the “Cowboy Days” Celebration and challenge yourself as you ride with your friends and set a new personal best time on FLAT, smooth, lightly traveled farm to market roads, wide shouldered highway, or interstate access roads. On some routes, there are a few, short, easy inclines (can’t call them hills in West Texas, we don’t have hills, just playa lakes!).
